BIRTH: Alice was born on 10 May 1890.

PARENTS: Alice's father was Willie Metcalfe, a woollen manufacturer worker, and her mother was Mary Ann Metcalfe, nee Moorhouse. They were married at All Hallows Kirkburton on 13 June 1885.

Willie's father was William Metcalfe, a wool sorter, and Mary Ann's father was Joah Moorhouse, a mason.

Willie and Mary had three children – Alice born 1890, Herbert born 1893 and Ann born 1897.

DEATH: Alice died a spinster on 17 April 1951 at Moor View Hospital, Meltham, Huddersfield and her home address was Far Dene, Kirkburton. Probate was granted on 13 June 1951 to her brother Herbert.

OTHER INFORMATION: At the time of the 1911 census, Alice was living with her parents, siblings and mother in law Ann Moorhouse at Far Dene. Alice was a warper, Herbert was a beamer and Ann was a winder.

Alice's brother Herbert served during the Great War and survived - his name is listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
