BIRTH: She was born Annie Lodge on 01 December 1878 in Lepton and was baptised on 02 February 1879 at Lepton Parish Church.

PARENTS: Annie's father was Franklin Wilson Lodge, manufacturer and her mother was Ellen Lodge, nee Carter. They were married on 30 December 1874 at All Hallows Parish Church, Kirkburton.

Franklin's father was John Lodge, a manufacturer, and Ellen's father was Lister Carter, an inn keeper.

Franklin and Ellen had four children – John Lister born 1876, Florence E born 1878, Annie born 1879 and Mary E born 1881.

Franklin died on 01 November 1881 when Ellen was 25. Ellen married James W Hill, a butcher of Kirkburton, on 14 February 1884 at St Paul's Church, Shepley.

MARRIAGE: Annie married William Jaggar Moxon, a worsted cloth manufacturer, at Lepton Parish Church on 13 September 1899.

William's father was Benjamin Horncastle Moxon, a manufacturer, and his mother was Elizabeth Ann Moxon, nee Jagger.

CHILDREN: Annie and William had two children – Benjamin Franklin Jagger Moxon, born 15 April 1901, and Ethel Mary Moxon, born 28 January 1909.

DEATH: Annie died on 29 June 1974 and her address was given as 8 Spa Terrace, Lepton.

OTHER INFORMATION: In the 1911 census, Annie and the family were living at Broom Bank, Kirkburton.
