BIRTH: She was born Agnes Ann Wood on 11 February 1872 and was baptised on 05 April 1874 at St Stephen's Church Lindley.

PARENTS: Agnes's father was Alfred Wood, a weaver, and her mother was Martha Ellen Wood, nee Shaw. Alfred and Martha were married at Halifax Parish Church on 13 August 1870.

Alfred's father was Joseph Wood, a weaver, and Martha Ellen's father was Jabez Shaw, a weaver of Halifax.

Alfred and Martha had five children – Fred born in 1869, Agnes Ann born in 1872, Mary H born in 1877, James W born in 1879 and George A born in 1880.

MARRIAGE: Agnes Ann married Arthur Oddy, a warehouseman from Blackley Manchester, at All Hallows Kirkburton on 21 October 1893. Arthur's father was Christopher Oddy, salesman.

CHILDREN: Agnes and Arthur two sons - Frank Wood Oddy, baptised at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton on 21 September 1894 and George Oddy, born in 1905 in Manchester.

DEATH: Agnes was a widow when she died on 19 November 1958 and probate was granted to her sons, Frank and George. At the time of her death she was living at Yew Tree Cottage, Kirkburton.

OTHER INFORMATION: Agnes's son Frank Wood Oddy served during the Great War and survived - his name is listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
