BIRTH: Ann Louisa was born on 17 December 1889 and was baptised on 06 April 1890 at St John the Evangelist Church, Golcar.

PARENTS: Ann Louisa's father was John Albert Singleton, an overlooker, and her mother was Sarah Ellen Singleton, nee Dyson.

Sarah and John Albert were married 10 June 1877 at St John the Evangelist Church, Golcar. Sarah's father was Thomas Dyson, a tuner.

MARRIAGE: Ann Louisa married Crowther Sugden, a carding engineer of Hartley Street, Dewsbury on 02 June 1921 at St Mark's Church, Dewsbury.

Crowther's father was George Sugden, a carding engineer and his mother was Mary Hannah Sugden. Ann Louisa's father was deceased at the time of their marriage.

Ada was a weaver in a woollen mill, Joe was a tuner in a woollen mill, Ann Louisa was a tailoring machinist, Jessie was a tailoring machinist, Willie was a beamer in a woollen mill and Hilda was still at school.

Ann Louisa was the sister in law of Elizabeth Singleton.

Ann's brothers Joe and Willie both served in the Great War and survived - their names are listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
