BIRTH: Flora Annie was born on 22 October 1869. She was baptised on 11 April 1873 on non-conformist baptism records

PARENTS: Flora's mother was Elizabeth Smith, but no father was recorded on her baptism record.

DEATH: Flora died on 27 May 1926 at the Sanatorium, Dalton, Huddersfield. Probate was granted to Harry Smith, her brother, who was a mill manager.

OTHER INFORMATION: Flora was living with her grandparents, Jonathan and Hannah Smith in Highburton in the 1871 censuses when she was 1 year old with her brother Harry Smith who was 5 years old. Harry was born on 18 February 1866 and baptised on 26 August 1866 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton but no father was listed on his baptism record.

Flora and Harry continued to live with their grandparents on subsequent censuses. Jonathan and Hannah also had six children of their own living with them at the time of the 1871 census, but Flora and Harry's mother was not living with them.

Her grandfather was Jonathan Smith, a fancy weaver, and her grandmother was Hannah Smith nee Fitton.

As the permanent night nurse at the Kirkburton Hospital, Flora started with a salary of £1 per week, rising to £1/5s when the hospital closed in 1918.
