BIRTH: She was born born Harriet Ann Shaw on 12 January 1870

PARENTS: Her father was David Stott Shaw, gas works manager, and her mother was Mary Shaw, nee Bamforth. David was born in Lindley and Mary was born in Slaithwait. They were married at St. Peter's Church, Huddersfield in September 1861. They had eight children – James, John W, Harriet Ann, Louisa, Louis, Arthur, David H and Eleanor.

MARRIAGE: Harriet married Jonathan William Crossley, house carpenter, who was born at Farnley Tyas, on 21 September 1895. Jonathan was living at Armitage Bridge at the time of their marriage and his father was William Copley, farmer.

CHILDREN: Harriet and Jonathan had one son, Frank who was baptised on 05 April 1896 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton.

DEATH: Harriet died in September 1951

OTHER INFORMATION: In the 1911 census their son Frank Crossley, occupation worsted drawing, aged 15 was living with them at Park View. Frank served in the Great War and returned – he is listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
