BIRTH: Elizabeth was born in Delph and was baptised privately on 29 June 1878 in the parish of Friar-mere, York.

PARENTS: Elizabeth's father was Richard Farrar and her mother was Ann Farrar. At the time of her baptism her father was a shoemaker.

MARRIAGE: Elizabeth married Herbert Armitage at the Parish Church, Taunton St James, Somerset on 21 April 1897.

Her husband was born in Netherton, Huddersfield and was a worsted spinning employer. Herbert's father was Law Armitage, and he was listed as a manufacturer at the time of their marriage.

Elizabeth's father, Richard Farrar, was listed a Gentleman at the time of their marriage.
