Additional Information:

BIRTH: She was born Agnes Shaw on 02 June 1856 and baptized at Kirkburton on 16 June 1867.

PARENTS: Agnes's parents were Jabez Shaw and Alice Shaw, nee Goldthorpe, who were married at Kirkburton on 17 July 1843. Jabez's father was Joseph Shaw, clothier and Alice's father was David Goldthorpe, also a clothier.

MARRIAGE: Agnes married Arthur Geissler, dyer, in January 1893. Arthur was born on 04 November 1852

CHILDREN: Agnes and Arthur had two children – Herman Gustav born in 1897 but only lived for one month and Harriet Theresa who was baptised on 12 April 1895 at All Hallows, Kirkburton.

Before Agnes married Arthur Geissler she had a son, George Robert Shaw, who was born on 04 October 1882 and baptised on 05 July 1883 – no father was named on the baptism records. After his mother's marriage, George's name was changed to George Robert Shaw Geissler.

DEATH: Agnes died in June 1945

OTHER INFORMATION: Arthur was a dyer in the 1911 census but subsequently became an auctioneer and land valuer.

Agnes's son, George Robert Shaw Geissler, served during the Great War and returned - his name is listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.

Agnes and Arthur's daughter Harriet also worked at the Kirkburton Military Hospital.
