BIRTH: Ethel was born on 07 September 1887

PARENTS: Ethel's father was James Brook, a weaver, and her mother was Ellen Brook, nee Hardcastle, of Bitchel Kirkburton.

Her parents were married on 22 June 1856 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton. Ellen's father was William Hardcastle, a weaver, and James's father was Charles Brook, a banksman.

Ethel's parents had six other children – Harry born 1889, Lilly born 1891, Lewis born 1892, and Charles born 1894 who were all born in Kirkburton. Annie born 1896, and Hilda born 1898, were both born in Milnsbridge.
